Reporting to the Paint Shop Manager the Aircraft Paint prepper will be responsible for the paint preparation process for aircraft according to our polices and customer expectations.

Responsibilities

- Cleaning, de-corroding, sanding, washing and general prep work of aircraft/ parts prior to paint
- Masking of aircraft and touch-up priming/painting of parts
- Accurately read and follow productions schedule to ensure all components are ready to be painted on time
- Cleaning and organizing of paint shop facilities
- Disassemble, clean, and reassemble sprayers and power equipment using solvents, wire brushes and cloths

Required Skills, Knowledge & Qualifications

- 1-2 years experience preferred
- Must be able to obtain and retain a Transport Canada Airport Pass (RAIC)
- Mechanical aptitude and ability to work safely with basic hand tools
- Ability to wear extensive PPE for long periods of time
- Understand technical manuals, drawings, and blueprints
- Ability to accurately read a scale and tape measure an asset
- Able to carry out the physical requirements of the job including (but not limited to): bending, stooping, crouching, reaching, twisting, lifting, performing repetitive tasks, walking, and standing for long extended periods of time
